Forms must be complete (including signatures and payment) in order to be accepted for scheduling. All completed test applications and fees must be received by ARFSC at least THREE WEEKS PRIOR TO THE TEST DATE REQUIRED. Priority on tests will be given to ARFSC members. Test applications will be processed in the order in which they are received. Test fees are NON-REFUNDABLE unless cancellation is due to a doctor certified injury (to be received within 7 days of the test), judges/ice availability, or if there are too few skaters for a session. A request to move a test to a later date will be considered a cancellation and a new test application and fees must be re-submitted. There are NO REFUNDS for contingent tests in a session that do not run because the initial test was not passed. Late test requests (less than seven days before the test session) if accepted, require a \$25 late processing fee.

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Virtual test policies for ARFSC

In addition to adhering to all USFS rules and regulations the following policies are enforced by ARFSC:

Test applications:

All test applications will require the signature of a coach that is in full compliance with USFS certification and currency requirements. These include:

Current USFS membership with self identification in a coaching role
Current liability insurance through either USFS or ISI
Current Background check
Current Safesport Training
Core coach training and certification
Member of USFS Coach ICE
Code of Ethics Agreement
Misc Waivers required by USFS

Payment must accompany a test application.

Coaches will need to be disclosed to USFS when registering for a test.

Test Sessions:

Only coaches meeting the USFS currency requirements may accompany a test candidate to a test session at ARFSC. No additional coaching will be allowed. This is to adhere to USFS policies. No exceptions. Non-USFS coaches may observe the test from the balcony only!

Proctors should be an adult member of ARFSC who meets the USFS proctoring requirements and who is familiar with USFS testing procedures. Proctors will be co-located with the videographer at the time of the test and observe all proceedings. USFS proctoring restrictions include:

The proctor must be an impartial person of authority (i.e., test chair, rink management, skating school director, board member or local skating official) but may NOT be a coach/choreographer who has worked with the candidate, a training mate who takes from the same coach or is a personal friend of the candidate, or a parent/guardian of the athlete or any training mates.

Proctors must watch the test performance, verify that the full performance was completed on the date and time indicated in the athlete's recording as a single continuous recording, and complete the performance affidavit.
